#### (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the District Council of Blaby (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") are satisfied that traffic should be restricted by reason of the holding of the Cosby Yam Bomb Event at which will cause the street to be thronged and liable to be obstructed.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercising its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847 and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Save as provided by Article 4 the use of the road specified in Schedule 1 and through traffic is prohibited for the following hours on the following day except upon the direction of the Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden:

From 09:00 on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2024 To 17:00 on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024 (22 days)

- Any persons not complying with this Order shall in accordance with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847 as amended by the Criminal Justice Act, 1967 be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £1,000.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle to be used on the said road for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation as provided by Article 1 thereof and may be cited in the District of Blaby (Lay-by, The Nook) Cosby (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2024.
